## This funding will be used to

Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English, across all levels of learning, from 80% (2019 Semester 2) to 85% (2020)

## Our initiatives include

- develop teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust intra-school and inter-school moderation
- develop a whole school approach to teaching literacy to support the teaching of literacy across all learning areas
- strengthen the case management approach to students using Sharratt's Case Management model for identified students.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- develop and implement a whole school approach to teaching writing (aligned to the Australian curriculum), embedding and aligning Sheena Cameron's "How to teach Writing" and Dr Heggarty's Phonological Program TRS & PD \$7000
- embed the culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice/action learning (inclusive of Teacher Aides) TRS & PD \$2000
- allocate TRS to support year level moderation and cross-year moderation working groups, twice a term, in week 8 & 10. \$10 000
- allocate TRS to support case management approach for teachers across each year level. twice a term. \$5000
