This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving an "A & B" in English and Mathematics across all levels of learning; Semester 2 2021 average P-6 80% to P-6 average 85% in Semester 2 2022.
- Continue to maintain Semester 2 2021 results in English and Mathematics 100% of students P-6 receiving a 'C' or above in English and Mathematics.

Our initiatives include

- Embed and extend teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content, descriptors and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust intra and inter school moderation processes.
- Develop teacher aide knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content, descriptors and achievement standards through inclusion in pre – moderation and student case management.
- Embed highly effective pedagogy across the whole school in literacy and numeracy, inclusive of the Indigenous 8 Ways of Learning to support 'every student succeeding'.
- Continue to strengthen the case management approach for students using Sharratt's Case Management model for identified students and build whole staff knowledge of co-constructed data wall – inclusive of English and Mathematics levels of achievement.
